ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATION DESIGNATION

A. DEFINITION:

A three-position alphanumeric code which identifies the attainment of skills and knowledges, certified by competent authority, in addition to those identified by the officer's Designator.

The AQD codes consist of three characters, either alphanumeric or all-numeric. The first character of an alphanumeric code identifies a broad occupational area closely related to the Designator. The second character specifies the qualifications appropriate to that occupational area with the third character further defining the specific qualifications.

A maximum of 20 Additional Qualification Designations will be maintained on the database, in reverse chronological order, with the most recent being in Occurrence 2. Occurrence 1 is the Primary AQD.

REMARKS: The AQD codes become a permanent part of the Officer's record unless specifically changed or deleted.
