A one-position alphanumeric code used to record the level of an officer's educational achievement. The levels range from less than high school through the doctoral degree. The levels of education have necessarily been reduced to a workable number with the result that there is some arbitrary grouping. The level of education cannot be determined unless the major field of study is known.

REMARKS: A maximum of five levels are sorted in descending order with the highest level of education stored in Occurrence 1. All of the associated EDUCATION - UNIVERSITY data elements pertaining to the Level are stored based on this sort.
