NAVAL OFFICER BILLET CLASSIFICATION - CODE

A. DEFINITION:

A four-position alphanumeric code which identifies a qualification acquired by an officer by virtue of serving in a billet identified by that code in a manpower authorization. NOBCs identify officer billet requirements and officer occupational experience acquired through billet experience or through a combination of education and experience. An NOBC provides a general description of duties performed in a billet.

The first position of the code identifies the field.

The second position identifies the group within the field.

The third and fourth positions indicate the specific billet classification within the group.

Special NOBCs exist which identify certain flag officers and flag officer selectees. The NOBCs are four position codes beginning with an "A" (A001, etc.) and are controlled by the Chief of Naval Operations.

REMARKS: A maximum of three NOBC codes may be recorded for each Duty Station.

A maximum of twelve sets of NOBC codes will be maintained on the database in reverse chronological order, with the current NOBC Codes associated with the Current Duty Station in Occurrence 1. Occurrence 2 is associated with Past Duty Station 1, Occurrence 3 is associated with Past Duty Station 2, etc.

For the C8, F8, G8, and H8 TACS, NOBC is program generated using the BILLET File.

NAVAL OFFICER BILLET CLASSIFICATION - MONTHS

A. DEFINITION:

A two-position numeric code indicating the number of months an officer served in a billet which resulted in acquiring, utilizing, and earning a Naval Officer Billet Classification Code. Naval Officer Billet Classifications are generally not recorded if the number of months the billet was held was less than five months.

REMARKS: A maximum of three NOBC months associated with the three NOBC codes may be recorded for each Duty Station.

A maximum of twelve sets of NOBC codes and months will be maintained on the database in reverse chronological order, with the current NOBC Codes and Months associated with the Current Duty Station in Occurrence 1. Occurrence 2 is associated with Past Duty Station 1, Occurrence 3 is associated with Past Duty Station 2, etc.

Program generated by computing the difference between the begin and end billet dates. Begin date is always the date of the billet; End date may be the billet date of the new duty or date reported to the new activity or date of loss from the activity.

PROMOTION STATUS

A. DEFINITION:

A maximum four-position alphanumeric code which indicates an officer's selection or failure of selection for promotion to the next grade higher than his/her current grade. This data element is made up of two parts. The first is a one-position code indicating the status, and the next three positions are one-position date fields indicating the fiscal year of selection or failure.

REMARKS: When an officer who has previously failed selection is selected, all failure information will be erased from the record and replaced by the promotion status code and year.

B. REFERENCE DOCUMENT, CODE, OR FORMAT:

CODE DEFINITION

C	Indicates an officer (CAPT and above) has been considered by a Selection Board in his/her current grade, but not chosen. (Similar to code F.)
D	Indicates an officer has chosen to be deferred until the next Selection Board. This is followed by a single position year.
F	Indicates an officer has failed selection. This code is followed by a single position year for each fiscal year of failure up to three years. In the event of more than three failures, the first year, second year, and the most recent year will be shown.
S	Indicates an officer has been selected for the next higher grade. This is followed by a single position year to indicate the fiscal year the selection was made.
Blank	Indicates an officer has not been considered by a Selection Board in his/her current grade.
